## **Applicant Responsibilities:**

- 1. Correspondents will be provided by en mail and phone only.
- 2. You must reply to the administrator in a timely fashion, failure to do will result in not being mentored.
- 3. We only have <u>50 spots</u> available for students and will be based on first come first service basis.
- 4. Students under the age of 20 will be given first priority.
- 5. Anyone is eligible to apply.
- 6. Students under the age of 19 must have a parent or guardian with them for the entire day.
- 7. Applicants must phone their instructor 24-hours prior to their mentoring date.
- 8. Applications must fill out a post-mentoring survey.
- 9. Students must arrive 30 minutes early on the day of their mentoring program.
- 10. Students must come prepared for the day. Proper clothing for the weather and have a lunch.
- 11. Students **must** fill out a waiver and photo release form when they arrive for mentoring. **Bonus:** 
  - 1. Students will be reimbursed for up to a total of 100 km of travel at a rate of 0.40 per km.
  - 2. Each student will receive a safety and trapping kit valued at \$75.
