Applicant Responsibilities:

1. Correspondents will be provided by en mail and phone only.
2. You must reply to the administrator in a timely fashion, failure to do will result in not being mentored.
3. **We only have 50 spots available** for students and will be based on first come first service basis.
4. Students under the age of 20 will be given first priority.
5. Anyone is eligible to apply.
6. Students **under the age of 19 must** have a parent or guardian with them for the entire day.
7. Applicants **must** phone their instructor 24-hours prior to their mentoring date.
8. Applications **must** fill out a post-mentoring survey.
9. Students **must** arrive 30 minutes early on the day of their mentoring program.
10. Students **must** come prepared for the day. Proper clothing for the weather and have a lunch.
11. Students **must** fill out a waiver and photo release form when they arrive for mentoring.

Bonus:

1. Students will be reimbursed for up to a total of 100 km of travel at a rate of 0.40 per km.
2. Each student will receive a safety and trapping kit **valued at \$75.**
